

SKAO Code of Ethics


- Follows on from "Code of Conduct for Meetings"

SKA1 Science Milestones



- Please continue to provide your input!
- Key take-away messages so far include:
 - Longer time interval between Allocation and Scheduling of KSPs
 - Need for clarity around: KSP versus PI definition, "level playing field" for different observing modes, access policy implementation
- Plan for Discussion Session during September Meeting/Workshop



SKA Data Challenges

- Ongoing consultation with SWGs on what they would need from an SKA data challenge
 - What is a plausible database/data-product size and data format?
 - What aspect is of greatest interest to you (e.g. Visibility-based, imagecube-based, time series, calibration, source extraction, etc.)
 - What data format is most desirable?
- Ongoing planning of the Challenges activities, including
 - Availability of codes/tools for producing simulated datasets;
 - Availability of real data from pathfinder/precursors that could be relevant;
 - Computing resources available
 - Options for hosting the database
